MINUTES**

Tuesday, March 24, 2009

A meeting of the Sullivan's Island Beach Erosion Advisory Committee was held at 6:00pm Tuesday, March 24, 2009 in Town Council Chambers, 1610 Middle Street all requirements of the Freedom of Information Act having been satisfied. Present were committee members Vice-Chairman Dr. Peter DeVito, Secretary Vince Sottile, Jerry Kaynard, Larry Middaugh, Aaron Nettles and Jeffrey Short.

- I. **Call to Order.** Vice-Chairman Peter DeVito called the meeting to order.
- II. **Approval of the Minutes.** There was motion, a second, and unanimous vote to amend the minutes from the February 24<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- III. **Old Business.** Gregg Gress was present and made observations, from the beach, of areas where erosion could affect the water and sewer systems. There was a discussion about the proposed setback line issued by OCCRM. The line runs through a few residents' lots and close to the water and sewer lines. There was a motion, a second, and a unanimous vote to have the Town of Sullivan's Island to file a resolution to DHEC-OCRM. The basis of this resolution is that the proposed critical line will hinder the Town's Department of Water and Sewer from properly maintaining the utility system located within the critical area.
- IV. **New Business.** Island resident Skippy Weil was present and voiced his concern with the proposed critical line. The line runs through his property and would hinder him from ever making any improvements to his property between the critical line and the setback line. He thinks the line is unconstitutional, thinks he should be grandfathered in, objects to sandbags, objects to the setback line (he does not understand how it is established), and has had problems with DHEC-OCRM and sandbags once before a hurricane.
- V. **Adjournment.** There was a motion, a second, and a unanimous vote by the committee to adjourn for the evening.
