BEACH EROSION ADVISORY COMMITTEE
MINUTES (ANMENDED)
Tuesday, February 24, 2009

A meeting of the Sullivan's Island Beach Erosion Advisory Committee was held at 6:00pm Tuesday, February 24, 2009 in Town Council Chambers, 1610 Middle Street all requirements of the Freedom of Information Act having been satisfied. Present were committee members Chairman Wade Logan, Vice-Chairman Dr. Peter deVito, Secretary Vince Sottile, Jerry Kaynard, George Deytens, Larry Middaugh, Aaron Nettles and Jeffrey Short.

I. **Call to Order.** Chairman Wade Logan called the meeting to order.

II. **Presentation by Greg Gress of the Town of Sullivan's Island Water and Sewer.** Mr. Gress presented to the committee where the utility lines are located in areas vulnerable to erosion. He said that if sea water were to get into the water and sewer lines the entire system would have to be shut down and flushed, which could leave the residents of the island without water for days. The utilities are normally located under the house and usually near the ground which can be exposed to rising sea levels. The committee has asked Greg to make a list of trouble areas and solutions for the residents to keep salt water out of the utility lines. Gregg has said that he is in favor of using rip-rap to control erosion.

III. **Next Meeting Date and Time.** The committee has agreed to meet on March 24, 2009 and April 28, 2009 at 6:00pm.

IV. **Adjournment.** There was a motion, a second, and a unanimous vote by the committee to adjourn for the evening.
