A public hearing was held on the above date at Town Hall regarding Charleston County Grant Administration Needs, all requirements of the Freedom of Information Act having been satisfied:

There were three members in the audience, including one member of the media.

Betty McZorn, Program Administrator for Grants Administration at Charleston County, gave a summary of the five year consolidated plan, and stated this is the second year in the plan. She distributed the program performance and the target goals. There are no new procedures when applying for funds in the 08-09 year, but the application will be available on-line as of November 1, 2007.

Councilman Perkis stated that while only 12% of our population meets the County's criteria, senior/public access could possibly be a project for consideration. Mayor Smith noted that when the new Ben Sawyer bridge is built, a bike path would be needed on the other side of the bridge also, which should be considered.

There being no further business to come before Council, the special meeting was adjourned.
