Denise Jefferson, Community Development Manager of the Charleston County Grants Administration Department, presented to Council the goals and strategies for Charleston County Community Development. The Charleston County federal allocation from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is used toward five goals. The five goals are housing, the homeless, improving and/or expanding community facilities, economic development, and facilitating communities with adequate infrastructure. The training conference for the application will be held on December 3, 2008; applications for funding will be accepted from December 15, 2008 through January 15, 2009.
