A Special Meeting of Sullivan's Island Town Council was held on the above date at Town Hall, all requirements of the Freedom of Information Act having been satisfied:

Mayor Smith called the meeting to order at 3:25 pm and stated that the press and public were duly notified in accordance with State law. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss Unit Four of the Accreted Land Management Plan.

Motion was made by Councilman Kaynard, seconded by Councilwoman Watson, to amend the agenda to add a resolution reaffirming support and commitment to the Charleston County School District for construction of Sullivan's Island Elementary School, carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Councilman Kaynard, seconded by Councilwoman Watson, to approve a Resolution by the Town of Sullivan's Island Reaffirming Support and Commitment to the Charleston County School District for the Construction and Operation of An Elementary School of Sullivan's Island, carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Councilman Kaynard, seconded by Councilwoman McGee, to allow a 20 minute limit for public comment on the accreted land; motion failed by a vote of 4-3.

At this time, Councilman O'Neil began review of changes to Unit Four of the Accreted Land Management Plan.

There being no further business to come before Council, the meeting was adjourned.
