PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, at 11:00 AM on November 11, 1918, after four years of conflict, world peace was reestablished with the signing of an Armistice by the Allied Forces and the government of Germany for the cessation of World War I; and,

WHEREAS, 116,516 Americans made the ultimate sacrifice during that conflict to ensure lasting peace; and,

WHEREAS, in order for a grateful Nation to pay homage to veterans of all wars, on June 1, 1954, President Dwight Eisenhower signed into law a bill renaming Armistice Day to Veterans Day; and,

WHEREAS, two residents of Sullivan’s Island, Alexander Izlar and Marion Keenan, were among those that gave their lives in service of the Nation during World War I known at the time as “The Great War”; and,

WHEREAS, the tolling of bells is a traditional expression of honor and remembrance; and,

WHEREAS, in November 2018, the Nation will commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Armistice that ended the fighting in World War I at 11 AM, November 11, 1918 – the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Patrick M. O’Neil, Mayor of the Town of Sullivan’s Island, do hereby proclaim November 11, 2018 to be

ALEXANDER IZLAR AND MARION KEENAN DAY

on Sullivan’s Island and call upon all residents, as the bells of Stella Maris Catholic Church and The Church of the Holy Cross toll, to remember those who sacrificed while serving the Nation.
