Mayor Pat O'Neil asks that you lend your support to these two important efforts.

1. Fire Department Supplies Drive:

The Sullivan's Island Fire Department partners with the Isle of Palms Fire Department to assist North Carolina residents suffering from the devastation caused by Hurricane Florence.

Many Island residents will remember the kindness and assistance from small rural North Carolina communities given to the barrier islands after Hurricane Hugo. This is an opportunity to either give back or pay it forward!!!

Through October 3, 2018 you may donate supplies such as water, baby needs, building supplies, tarps, personal hygiene products or even Walmart gift cards. Articles of clothing are not needed.

Items may be dropped at the Sullivan's Island Fire Station at 2056 Middle Street or the Isle of Palms Public Safety Building on JC Long Boulevard on Isle of Palms.

2. Lowcountry Mayors' Disaster Relief Fund

The Lowcountry Mayors' Disaster Relief Fund has been established, which will raise money exclusively for Hurricane Florence-related disaster assistance via the Coastal Community Foundation's Disaster Relief Fund. You can designate the Mayors' Fund or to other Coastal Community Foundation funds for direct assistance to storm victims, designating the geographic area to which you wish your contribution to go.
