WORKSHOP/SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**

Thursday, May 22, 2008

A workshop/special meeting of the Town of Sullivan's Island Planning Commission was held at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, May 22, 2008 in Town Council Chambers, 1610 Middle Street all requirements of the Freedom of Information Act having been satisfied. Present were Commission members Chairman Hal Currey, Vice-Chairman John Winchester, Aussie Geer, Nicky Bluestein, Anne Osborne Kilpatrick and Elaine Fowler; Zoning Administrator Kent Prause and Assistant to Administrator Lisa Darrow. Absent was Bobby Thompson.

I. Call to Order. Chairman Currey called the meeting to order, stated the press and public were duly notified pursuant to state law and confirmed the Commission had a quorum of members present.

III. Review of Town Comprehensive Plan – Needs & Goals

Chairman Currey noted the Commission would continue its review of element Needs & Goals, originally handled in regular Planning Commission. He noted the Commission remained committed to finalizing a draft Comprehensive Plan by late July/August to send to Council for its consideration. Chairman Currey welcomed Ms. Vonie Gilreath, Senior Planner, of BCD-COG to assist with this meeting.

Thereafter the Commission reviewed the current Comprehensive Plan Needs & Goals, for updates, revisions and/or additions (**attached as Exhibits A and B): Community Facilities and Natural Resources (latter half).**

The Planning Commission will continue work on the Comprehensive Plan at its next special meeting/workshop scheduled from 5:00pm – 6:30pm at Town Hall on Wednesday, June 11, 2008. The element to be reviewed will be Land Use.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:35 p.m.
