#### CHAPTER 10

# LICENSES<sup>1</sup>

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#### Sec. 10-1. License required.

Every person engaged or intending to engage in any calling, business, occupation or profession listed in the rate classification index portion of this ordinance, in whole or in part, within the limits of the Town of Sullivan's Island, South Carolina, is required to pay an annual license fee and obtain a business license as herein provided. (11-17-80, S1; 12-15-92)

## Sec. 10-2. Definitions.

The following works, terms and phrases, when used in this ordinance, shall have the meaning ascribed herein:

A. "Business" means a calling, occupation, profession or activity engaged in with the

object of gain, benefit or advantage, either directly or indirectly. A charitable organization shall be deemed a business unless the entire proceeds of its operation are devoted to charitable purposes.

- B. "Town" means the Town of Sullivan's Island.
- C. "Classification" means that division of businesses by major groups subject to the same license rate as determined by a calculated index of ability to pay based on national averages, benefits, equalization of tax burden, relationship of services, or other basis deemed appropriate by Town Council.
- D. "Gross Income" means all income whatever source derived, unless excluded by law, collected by a business within or working within the Town, excepting business done wholly outside the Town on which a business license tax is paid to some other municipality or county and reported to the Town. Gross income includes income realized in any form, whether in money, property or services. Income may be realized, therefore, in the form of services, meals, accommodations, stock or other property, as well as cash. In the case of brokers or agents, gross income shall mean gross commissions. (12/16/08)
- E. "License Inspector" means the Town Clerk, or other person designated to administer this Ordinance.
- F. "Person" means any individual, firm, partnership, cooperative non-profit membership, corporation, joint venture, association, estate, trust, business trust, receiver, syndicate, holding company, or other group or combination acting as a unit, in the singular or plural, and the agent or employee having charge or control of a business in the absence of the principals. (11-17-80, S2; 12-15-92)

## Sec. 10-3. Purpose and duration.

The business license levied by this ordinance is for the purpose of providing such regulation as may be required by the business subject thereto and for the purpose of raising revenue for the general fund through a privilege tax. Each license shall be issued for one year and shall expire on December 31. The provisions of this ordinance and the rates herein shall remain in effect from year to year as amended by Town Council. (11-17-80, S3; 12-15-92)

## Sec. 10-4. License fee.

The required license fee shall be paid for each business subject hereto according to the applicable rate classification on or before the 1st day of February in each year. A separate license shall be required for each place of business and for each classification or business conducted at one place. If gross income cannot be separated for classification at one location, the license fee shall be computed on the combined gross income for the classification requiring the highest rate. A license fee based on gross income shall be

computed on the gross income for the preceding calendar or fiscal year, and on a twelve month projected income based on the monthly average for a business in operation for less than one year. The fee for a new business shall be computed on the estimated probable gross income stated in the license application for the balance of the calendar year. (11-17-80, S4; 12-15-92)

## Sec. 10-5. Registration required.

The owner, agent or legal representative of every business subject to this ordinance, whether listed in the classification index or not, shall register the business and make application for a business license on or before the due date of each year, except that a new business shall be required to have a business license prior to operation within the town. Application shall be on a form provided by the License Inspector which shall contain the Social Security Number and/or the Federal Employer's Identification Number, the business name as reported on South Carolina income tax return, and all information about the applicant and the business deemed necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance by the License Inspector. The applicant shall certify under oath that the information given in the application is true, that the gross income is accurately reported, or estimated for a new business, without any unauthorized deductions, and that all assessments and personal property taxes due and payable to the Town have been paid. Insurance agents and brokers shall report the name of each insurance company for which a policy was issued and the total premiums collected for each company for each type of insurance coverage on a form approved by the License Inspector. An insurance agent not employed by a company shall be licensed as a broker. (11-17-80, S5; 12-15-92)

## Sec. 10-6. Deductions and exemptions.

No deductions from gross income shall be made except income from business done wholly outside of the Town on which a license tax is paid to some other municipality or a country, or income which cannot be taxed pursuant to State OR Federal law. The applicant shall have the burden to establish the right to a deduction by satisfactory records and proof. No person shall be exempt from the requirements of the ordinance by reason of the lack of an established place of business within the Town, unless exempted by State or Federal law. The License Inspector shall determine the appropriate classification for each business in accordance with the latest issue of the U. S. Office of Management and Budget Standard Industrial Classification Manual. No person shall be exempt from this ordinance by reason of the payment of any other tax, unless exempted by State law, and no person shall be relieved of the liability for the payment of any other tax by reason of the application of this ordinance. (11-17-80, S6; 12-15-92)

# Sec. 10-7. False application unlawful.

It shall be unlawful for any person subject to the provisions of this ordinance to make a false application for the business license, or to give or file, or direct the giving or filing, of any false information with respect to the license or fee required by this ordinance. (11-17-80, S7; 12-15-92)

## Sec. 10-8. Display and transfer.

All persons shall display the license issued to them on the original form provided by the License Inspector in a conspicuous place in the business establishment at the address shown on the license. A transient or non-resident shall carry the license upon his person or in a vehicle used in the business, readily available for inspection by any authorized agent of the Town. A change of address must be reported to the License Inspector within ten (10) days after removal of the business to a new location and the license will be valid at the new address upon written notification of the License Inspector and compliance with zoning and building codes. Failure to obtain the approval of the License Inspector for a change of address shall invalidate the license and subject the licensee to prosecution for doing business without a license. A business license shall not be transferable and transfer of ownership shall be considered a termination of the old business and the establishment of a new business requiring a new business license, based on the old business income. (11-17-80, S8; 12-15-92)

#### Sec. 10-9. Administration of Ordinance.

The License Inspector shall administer the provisions of this ordinance, collect license fees, issue licenses, make or initiate investigation audits to insure compliance, initiate denial or revocation procedures, report violations to the Police Department and assist in prosecution of violators, produce forms, make reasonable regulations relating to the administration of this ordinance, and perform such other duties as may be assigned. (11-17-80, S9; 12-15-92)

#### Sec. 10-10. Examination and Audits.

For the purpose of enforcing the provisions of this ordinance the License Inspector or other authorized agent of the Town may be empowered by Town Council to examine and audit books and records. In the event an audit or examination of books and records reveals that false information has been filed by the licensee, the costs of the audit shall be added to the correct license fee and late penalties in addition to other penalties provided herein. Each day of failure to pay the proper amount of license fee shall constitute a separate offense. Records of inspection and audits shall not be deemed public records, and the License Inspector shall not release the reported gross income of any person by name without permission of the licensee, provided that statistics complied by classifications may be made public. (12-15-92)

#### Sec. 10-11. Assessments.

When any person shall have failed to obtain a business license or to furnish the information required by this ordinance or the License Inspector, the License Inspector shall proceed to examine such records of the business or any other available records as may be appropriate and to conduct such investigations and statistical surveys as he may deem appropriate to assess a license tax and penalties as provided herein. A notice of assessment shall be served by certified mail and an application for adjustment of the assessment may be made to the License Inspector within five (5) days after the notice is mailed or the assessment will become final. The License Inspector shall establish by regulation the procedure for hearing an application for adjustment of assessment and/or issuing a notice of final assessment. A final assessment may be appealed to Town Council only by payment in full of the assessment under protest within five (5) days and the filing of written notice of appeal within ten (10) days after payment pursuant to the provision of this ordinance relating to appeals to Town Council. (12-15-92)

# Sec. 10-12. Delinquent license fees.

For non-payment of all or any part of the correct license fee, the License Inspector shall levy and collect a late penalty of five (5%) percent of the unpaid fee for each month or portion thereof after the due date until paid. If any license fee shall remain unpaid for sixty (60) days after its due date, the License Inspector shall issue an execution which shall constitute a lien upon the property of the licensee for the tax, penalties and costs of collection, and shall proceed to collect in the same manner as prescribed by law for the collection of other taxes. (12-15-92)

# Sec. 10-13. Notices.

The License Inspector may, but shall not be required to, mail written notices that license fees are due, but if notices are not mailed there shall be published a notice of the due date in newspaper of general circulation within the Town three (3) times prior to the due date in each year. (12-15-92)

#### Sec. 10-14. Denial of Licensee.

The License Inspector shall deny a license to an applicant when the application is incomplete, contains a misrepresentation, false or misleading statement, evasion or suppression of a material fact, or when the activity for which a license is sought is unlawful or constitutes a public nuisance. A decision of the License Inspector shall be subject to appeal to Town Council as herein provided. Denial shall be written with reasons stated. (11-17-80, S12; 12-15-92)

#### Sec. 10-15. Suspension or revocation of license.

When the License Inspector determine that:

A. A license has been mistakenly or improperly issued or issued contrary to law; or

- B. A licensee has breached any condition upon which his license was issued or has failed to comply with the provisions of this chapter, or
- C. A licensee has obtained a license through a fraud, misrepresentation, a false or misleading statement, evasion or suppression of a material fact in the license application; or
- D. A licensee has been convicted of an offense under a law or ordinance regulating business, a crime involving moral turpitude, or an unlawful sale of merchandise or prohibited goods; or
- E. A licensee has engaged in an unlawful activity or nuisance relating to the business;

the License Inspector shall give written notice to the licensee or the person in control of the business within the Town by personal service or certified mail that the license is suspended pending a hearing before Town Council for the purpose of determining whether the license should be revoked. The notice shall state the time and place at which the hearing is to be held, which shall be at a regular or special Council meeting within thirty (30) days from the date of service of the notice. The notice shall contain a brief statement of the reasons for suspension and proposed revocation and a copy of the applicable provisions of this chapter. (11-19-79, S13; 12-15-92)

# Sec. 10-16. Appeals to Town Council.

- A. Any person aggrieved by a final assessment or a denial of a business license by the License Inspector may appeal the decision to Town Council by written request stating the reasons therefor filed with the License Inspector within ten (10) days after the payment of the assessment under protest or notice of denial is received.
- B. An appeal or a hearing on revocation shall be held by Town Council within thirty (30) days after receipt of a request for appeal or service of notice of suspension at a regular or special meeting of which the applicant or licensee has been given written notice. At such hearing all parties shall have the right to be represented by counsel, to present testimony and evidence and to cross-examine witnesses. The proceedings shall be recorded and transcribed at the expense of the party so requesting. The rules of evidence and procedure prescribed by Council shall govern the hearing. Town Council shall by majority vote of members present render a written decision based on findings of fact and the application of standards herein which shall be served upon all parties or their representatives and shall be final unless appealed to a court of competent jurisdiction within ten (10) days after service.
- C. No person who is denied a license or has had a license revoked shall be subject to prosecution for doing business without a license until the expiration of ten (10) days after

notice of revocation which is not appealed or until after final judgment of court upholding revocation. (11-80; 12-15-92)

#### Sec. 10-17. Confidentiality.

Except in accordance with proper judicial order or as otherwise provided by law, it shall be unlawful for any official or employee to divulge or make known in any particulars set forth or disclosed in any report or return required under this Ordinance. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the publication of statistics so classified as to prevent the identification of particular reports or returns.

#### Sec. 10-18. Violations.

Any person violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of an offense and shall be subject to a fine of up to \$500.00 or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or both, upon conviction. Each day of violation shall be considered a separate offense. Punishment for violation shall not relieve the offender of liability for delinquent penalties and costs provided for herein. (11-17-80, S15; 12-15-92)

# Sec. 10-19. Separability.

A determination that any portion of this ordinance is invalid or unenforceable shall not affect the remaining portions. (11-17-80, S16; 12-15-92)

<u>Sec. 10-20. Classification Rate Schedule.</u> (12/16/08) (12/18/12) (11/19/13) (12/16/14) (11-17-15)

The license fee for each Class of business shall be computed in accordance with the following rates. The major groups of businesses included in each Class are listed with the major group number according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual (SIC). The License Inspector shall determine the proper class for a business according to the SIC. (12-15-92)

## **NON-RESIDENT RATES**

Unless otherwise specifically provided, all minimum fees and rates shall be doubled for non-residents and itinerants having no fixed principal place of business within the municipality. In order for the business to be considered a resident business, the location must be the only location for the business or the location must generate at least eighty-five percent (85%) of the total income for the business.

A trailer at the construction site, a home office or structure in which the contractor resides is not a permanent place of business under this ordinance.

The total fee for the full amount of the contract shall be paid prior to commencement of work and shall entitle the contractor to complete the job without regard to the normal license expiration date.

No contractor shall be issued a business license until all state and municipal qualification examination and trade license requirements have been met. Each contractor shall post a sign in plain view on each job identifying the contractor with the job.

Sub-contractors shall be issued a business license until all state and municipal qualification examination and trade license requirements have been met. Each contractor shall post a sign in plain view on each job identifying the contractor with the job.

Sub-contractors shall be licensed on the same basis as general or prime contractors for the same job, and no deductions shall be made by a general or prime contractor for value of work performed by a sub-contractor.

No contractor shall be issued a business license until all performance and indemnity

bonds required by the Building code have been filed and approved. Zoning permits must be obtained when required by the Zoning Ordinance.

Each prime contractor shall file with the License Inspector a list of subcontractors furnishing labor or materials for each project.

Section 1.

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<u>Insurance Companies</u>: Except as to fire insurance, "gross premiums" means gross premiums written for policies for property or a risk located within the municipality. In addition, "gross premiums" shall include premiums written for policies that are sold, solicited, negotiated, taken, transmitted, received, delivered, applied for, produced or serviced by (1) the insurance company's office located in the municipality, (2) the insurance company's employee conducting business within the municipality, or (3) the office of the insurance company's licensed or appointed producer (agent) conducting business within the municipality, regardless of where the property or risk is located, provided no tax has been paid to another municipality in which the property or risk is located based on the same premium. (12-6-04) (11-20-12)

Solicitation for insurance, receiving or transmitting an application or policy, examination of a risk, collection or transmitting of a premium, adjusting a claim, delivering a benefit, or doing any act in connection with a policy or claim shall constitute conducting business within the municipality, regardless of whether or not an office is maintained in the municipality. (11-20-12)

As to fire insurance, "gross premiums" means gross premiums (1) collected in the municipality, and/or (2) realized from risks located within the limits of the municipality. (11-20-12)

Gross premiums shall include all business conducted in the prior calendar year. (11-20-12)

Gross premiums shall include new and renewal business without deductions for any dividend, credit, return premiums or deposit.

Declining rates shall not apply. (11-20-12)

#### Section 2.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this ordinance, license taxes for insurance companies shall be payable on or before May 31 in each year without penalty. The penalty for delinquent payments shall be 5% of the tax due per month, or portion thereof, after the due date until paid. (11-20-12)

#### Section 3.

Any exemptions in the business license ordinance for income from business in interstate commerce are hereby repealed. Gross income from interstate commerce shall be included in the gross income for every business subject to a business license tax. (11-20-12)

#### Section 4.

Pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. Sections 38-45-10 and 38-45-60, the Municipal Association of South Carolina is designated the municipal agent for purposes of administration of the municipal broker's premium tax. The agreement with the Association for administration and collection of current and delinquent license taxes from insurance companies as authorized by S.C. Code Section 5-7-300 and administration of the municipal broker's premium tax in the form attached hereto is approved and the mayor is authorized to execute it. (11-20-12)

All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. (11-20-12)

# Sec. 10-21. Compliance with Other Laws.

No license shall be issued unless the applicant has complied with all state and Town laws, regulations, and ordinances applicable to the conduct of the business. The listing of a business in any rate classification or index in this ordinance shall not be construed to allow operation of a business not permitted by the Zoning Ordinance. (12-15-92)

## Section 10-22. Telecommunications Services.

#### A. Maximum Rate Established by State Code.

- 1. Notwithstanding any other provisions of the Business License Ordinance, the business license tax for "retail telecommunications services", as defined in S. C. Code section 58-9-2200, shall be at the maximum rate authorized by S. C. Code section 58-9-2220, as it now provides or as provided by its amendment. The business license tax year shall begin on January 1 of each year. The rate for the 2005 business license tax year shall be the maximum rate allowed by State law as in effect on February 1, 2005. Declining rates shall not apply.
- 2. In conformity with S.C. Code section 58-9-2220, the business license tax for "retail telecommunications services" shall apply to the gross income derived from the sale of retail telecommunications services for the preceding calendar or fiscal year which either originate or terminate in the municipality and which are charged to a service address within the municipality regardless of where these amounts are billed or paid and on which a business license tax has not been paid to another municipality. The measurement of the amounts derived from the retail sale of mobile telecommunications services shall include only revenues from the fixed monthly recurring charge of customers whose service address is within the boundaries of the municipality. For a business in operation for less than one year, the amount of business license tax shall be computed on a twelve-month projected income.

#### B. Business License Period and Delinquent Penalty.

- 1. For the year 2005, the business license tax for "retail telecommunications services" shall be due on February 1, 2005, and payable by February 28, 2005, without penalty. For years after 2005, the business license tax for "retail telecommunications services" shall be due on January 1 of each year and payable by January 31 of that year, without penalty.
- 2. The delinquent penalty shall be five percent (5 %) of the tax due for each month, or portion thereof, after the due date until paid.

# C. Interstate Commerce Exemption.

Exemptions in the business license ordinance for income from business in interstate commerce are hereby repealed. Properly apportioned gross income from interstate commerce shall be included in the gross income for every business subject to a business license tax.

- D. Franchise or Contractual Agreements Expiring After December 31, 2003.
- 1. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be interpreted to interfere with continuing obligations of any franchise agreement or contractual agreement in the event that the franchise or contractual agreement should expire after December 31, 2003.
- 2. All fees collected under such a franchise or contractual agreement expiring after December 31, 2003, shall be in lieu of fees or taxes which might otherwise be authorized by this Ordinance.

#### E. Collection of Taxes.

As authorized by S. C. Code section 5-7-300, the Agreement with the Municipal Association of South Carolina for collection of current and delinquent license taxes from telecommunications companies pursuant to S. C. Code section 58-9-2200 shall continue in effect. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Agreement, for the year 2005, the Municipal Association of South Carolina is authorized to collect current and delinquent license taxes, in conformity with the due date and delinquent date for 2005 as set out in this Ordinance and is further authorized, for the year 2005, to disburse business license taxes collected, less the service charge agreed to, to this municipality on or before April 1, 2005, and thereafter as remaining collections permit.

#### F. Severability.

All previous ordinances, or portions of ordinances, in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. (10/4/04)
