In reference: Sullivan's Island Waterline Replacement Project Middle Street Crossings

Dear Residents,

We are excited to announce that the South Carolina Department of Transportation will be resurfacing Middle Street from Station 12 to Station 28 ½ beginning sometime mid to late February. This news has caused the Town to redirect our water line replacement efforts to all the Middle Street crossings. There are eight water mains that will need to be replaced which cross Middle Street. After meeting with Charleston County Public Works and SCDOT officials, it was determined the project will begin at Station 22 ½ Street moving east along Middle Street.

This work will be done by the Town in an effort to control costs. It is anticipated the work will be completed in three months. The project will replace enough of the water line at each intersection to clear the anticipated resurfacing work. Construction will begin January 28, 2009 at the intersection of Station 22 ½ and Middle Street. The work will proceed toward Breach Inlet with work at the intersections of Station 24, Station 26 and Station 28 ½. Thereafter, project work will be directed to Station 20, Station 18, Station 16, and finally Station 12. Water service interruption is expected to be minimal.

We have scheduled a preconstruction meeting for residents to attend on Tuesday January 27th in Fire Station at 5pm. Detail drawings and traffic control plan diagram are available for review. Staff will be available to answer questions. Project update meetings for residents will be held every two weeks thereafter.

Note that the traffic flow will be redirected in the business district during the construction activity while crossing Middle Street at Station 22 ½. It will be necessary to block the intersection to provide a safe work environment. Signs will prohibit thru traffic; however, access to businesses will be available. There are no plans to keep the intersection closed beyond 5pm. Please advise your patrons and vendors accordingly.
